Prepare to carry out clean-room cleaning operations



Overview

This standard is about making appropriate preparations for carrying out cleanroom cleaning operations. It includes confirming the specific details of the cleaning required and preparing yourself and your equipment to undertake cleaning.

Prepare to carry out clean-room cleaning operations

Get and confirm instructions and specific details of clean-room cleaning operations to be carried out

You must be able to:

- P1 obtain sufficient correct **details** about the cleaning operations that you are required to carry out
- P2 obtain sufficient **instructions or specific information** that could affect cleaning operations
- P3 have the **authority** to carry out the cleaning operations
- P4 clarify any details, instructions or specific information that you do not understand

Collect equipment and materials required

You must be able to:

- P5 obtain sufficient details about what **equipment**, **tools and materials** you might need
- P6 confirm that equipment, tools and materials are **appropriate** for cleaning clean-rooms and are available when you need them
- P7 confirm that equipment is operating properly and is safe to use
- P8 confirm that tools are safe to use
- P9 confirm that you have sufficient materials and that they are stored according to suppliers' instructions and are within use by date
- P10 confirm that any **instructions** for use of equipment, tools or materials are up to date and provide the information you need where appropriate

Dress for and enter clean-rooms

You must be able to:

- P11 obtain and wear all the correct **personal protective clothing** you need to enter clean-rooms in line with your instructions, **procedures** and guidelines
- P12 store any removed **personal items** in line with your instructions
- P13 **enter** clean-room environments following instructions, procedures or guidelines

Prepare to carry out clean-room cleaning operations

Knowledge and understanding

Get and confirm instructions and specific details of clean-room cleaning operations to be carried out

You need to know and understand:

- K1 what instructions or specific information you might need to carry out cleaning operations
- K2 how to get more information when you need it
- K3 specific information about clean-rooms that could affect how you carry out cleaning operations
- K4 what authority is needed to carry out cleaning operations
- K5 why authority is needed and where to get this authority

Collect equipment and materials required

You need to know and understand:

- K6 the types of equipment, tools and materials you need and where to get them
- K7 where to get instructions on the proper operation of equipment, tools and materials when you need them
- K8 the safety requirements for using equipment, tools and materials, including the Health and Safety at Work Act (HASAW) and Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) requirements
- K9 whether you need authorisation to use specialist equipment, tools or materials in clean-rooms and why this is important

Dress for and enter clean-rooms

You need to know and understand:

- K10 what personal protective clothing is appropriate for use and the purpose of each item
- K11 what action you should take if personal protective clothing is damaged, unsuitable or is potentially contaminated and why it is important to take this action
- K12 the procedures for putting on personal protective clothing, and why you must follow them
- K13 the procedures for entering clean-rooms, and why you must follow them;
- K14 what to do if there is the possibility of contamination whilst entering a clean-room and the implications if you ignore this possibility

Prepare to carry out clean-room cleaning operations

Additional Information

Scope/range

Get and confirm instructions and specific details of clean-room cleaning operations to be carried out:

- details of: location of clean room; activities carried out in clean-rooms; access to and availability of clean-rooms
- 2 **instructions or specific information** from: your client; your own organisation's procedures
- 3 instructions or specific information about: access; security; restrictions
- 4 **authority** from: client; own organisation e.g. access to sensitive or restricted areas.

Collect equipment and materials required:

- equipment: protective clothing; warning signs tools: hand tools; power tools; specialist tools
- 6 **materials**: non-linting cloths; cleaning solutions
- 7 appropriate: fitted with filtration systems; fitted with noise suppression; uses deionised water, fitted with double earth; fitted with radio frequency suppression; uses non-linting cloths
- 8 **instructions** from: manufacturer; your client; your own organisation's procedures

Dress for and enter clean-rooms:

- 9 personal protective clothing for use in the clean-room: footwear; headwear; gowns; overalls; gloves
- 10 **personal items**: jewellery; cigarettes; lighters; wallets
- 11 **procedures**: put on by yourself; assisted by other people
- enter via: airlocks; crossover bench; air shower; metal detectors; positive and negative air pressure systems
