Overview

This unit is about demonstrating knowledge of the stock inventory systems used by your organisation for items such as printed music, music for hire, or catalogues and other promotional items. You will be expected to be able to operate the system keeping it accurate and up to date. It is also important that you are able to analyse historical information to accurately forecast future stock requirements.

- K5 forecasting techniques
- K6 how stocks can be maintained at optimum levels within the policies of your organisation
