# **EUSRA21** Monitor and maintain health and safety in the workplace during recycling activities



# **Overview** This unit is designed for the candidate to demonstrate competence in monitoring and maintaining a healthy and safe working environment during recycling activities. The candidate is required to take care of the health and safety of themselves and others who may be affected by their work, including dealing with unplanned incidents. The candidate is also required to co-operate with their employer to help them comply with their duties under health and safety legislation, and not interfere with or misuse anything provided for their health, safety and welfare.

The term 'recycling' can refer to a variety of materials that are both recycled and treated including those in anaerobic digestion plants.

#### Use and communicate data and information

- P13 record and report incidents according to organisational procedures and practices
- P14 report, to an appropriate person, unsafe plant, equipment and hazardous situations outside your area of responsibility
- P15 give health and safety information to others in accordance with organisational procedures and practices
- P16 keep accurate and up to date records on routine and non-routine matters, and ensure they are legible and complete

#### You must be able to: Resolve problems which could affect health and safety

- P17 take appropriate action where incidents affect the health and safety of yourself and others
- P18 deal with unsafe behaviour in accordance with your responsibilities and workplace procedures
- P19 resolve day-to-day problems within your area of responsibility
- P20 refer matters outside your responsibility to the appropriate person
