Prepare accommodation for animals in a Home Office designated establishment



Overview

This standard covers the preparation of accommodation for animals in a Home Office designated establishment. You must be able to check environmental conditions such as temperature, humidity and light cycles. You must also make sure the accommodation is suitable for the animals.

You will be working under supervision to ensure that the health and welfare of the animals is maintained and that the necessary security is preserved.

This standard is for animal technologists and support staff who prepare accommodation for animals in a Home Office designated establishment.

	P2	clean and prepare animal accommodation in accordance with instructions
	P3	maintain appropriate levels of hygiene and bio-security
	P4	check fixtures and contents are appropriate for the animals to be housed
	P5	place animal/s into the accommodation according to recommended guidelines and instructions concerning stock densities
	P6	provide the appropriate information for accommodation labels and records
	P7	check environmental conditions meet requirements and report as necessary
	P8	comply with legislation relating to the care and welfare of animals in a Home Office designated establishment
	P9	follow instructions relating to entry and exit procedures at all times
	P10	carry out all work in accordance with relevant environmental and health and safety legislation, risk assessment requirements, codes of practice and company policies
