

Overview

This standard is about transporting live fish/shellfish. It requires that work is completed in accordance with site standard operating procedures.

The legislation controlling the application of this standard will vary depending on the location of the fish/shellfish farm within England, Wales, Northern Ireland or Scotland.

This standard is for those who transport live fish/shellfish.

Transport live fish/shellfish



Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- 1. carry out work safely in line with relevant health and safety requirements
- 2. maintain hygiene and bio-security during the transport of live fish/shellfish
- 3. load fish/shellfish safely into transport in a manner that avoids escape and minimises stress
- 4. maintain **environmental conditions** within **transport holding units** to ensure fish/shellfish health and welfare is maintained
- 5. transport live fish/shellfish efficiently with minimum time delay
- 6. observe behaviour of fish/shellfish for signs of stress during transport, where appropriate
- 7. observe and report on the condition of transported fish/shellfish
- 8. provide information to maintain records of the transport of live fish/shellfish in accordance with legal and site requirements



Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- 1. the relevant health and safety requirements associated with safe transportation of live fish
- 2. why it is important to move live fish/shellfish with minimum time delay
- 3. environmental conditions required to maintain the condition of fish/shellfish during transport
- 4. the importance of monitoring fish/shellfish health and welfare
- 5. how to recognise signs of stress in fish/shellfish
- 6. the importance of taking immediate action in the event of difficulties being encountered during transportation
- 7. why it is important to monitor the condition of transported fish/shellfish
- 8. the legal requirements that control the movement of live fish/shellfish between different locations
- 9. the dangers of transporting non-target species with fish/shellfish
- 10. the dangers to bio-security from the movement of live fish/shellfish
- 11. the legal and site requirements for maintaining records of the transport of live fish/shellfish
