LANCS1 Maintain safety of self and others in the workplace



Overview

This standard is about taking care of your own health and safety at work and the health and safety of others who may be affected by what you do. This includes being aware of hazards in the work area, wearing appropriate clothing (including protective clothing and equipment when it is required), following training and instructions about the way to do things safely and being aware of the consequences of your actions.

Performance criteria	P1	Carry out your work according to the training and instructions you have been given so that the health and safety of yourself and others is not put at risk
You must be able to:	P2	Recognise hazards in the work area and report them to an appropriate person
	P3	Wear suitable clothing for the work which you are undertaking
	P4	Wear personal protective equipment (PPE) where it has been assessed as a requirement for the work you are doing
	P5	Use safe methods of lifting and handling when moving items
	P6	Use and store equipment and materials safely and correctly
	P7	Keep the work area tidy at all times
	P8	Dispose of waste safely and correctly
	P9	Perform your work in a manner which minimises environmental damage
	P10	Report any accidents, incidents or problems without delay to an appropriate person and take necessary immediate action to reduce further danger.

You need to know and understand:

- K1 The types of hazards which may be present in your area of work
 - K2 The risks to health and safety and the measures put in place to control those risks
 - K3 Your responsibilities under relevant health and safety legislation and codes of practice
 - K4 What personal protective equipment (PPE) and clothing should be worn and how this should be cared for
- K5 Safe lifting and handling techniques
- K6 The correct and safe way to use and store equipment and materials required for your work
- K7 The importance of good housekeeping in the workplace
- K8 Correct methods for the disposal of waste
- K9 Methods of minimising environmental damage during your work
- K10 Why accidents, incidents and problems should be reported and the appropriate action to take
- K11 Procedures to be followed for different types of emergencies relevant to the industry in which you are working e.g. fire, accident.
