### LANCS57 Prepare and operate a tractor



#### Overview

This standard covers the basic preparation and operation of a tractor. The standard covers the use of tractors in a variety of weather conditions, ground conditions and terrain. These conditions will have an impact on the handling and use of the tractor.

When using a tractor on the public highway you will need to hold the appropriate licenses for both yourself and the tractor.

You must carry out your work in a way which will consider any impact on the natural environment.

This standard is suitable for anyone who operates a tractor on or off the public highway.

# Performance criteria

You must be able to: P1 wear appropriate clothing and personal protective equipment

- P2 prepare the tractor by carrying out pre-start checks and adjustments in accordance with specifications
- P3 confirm the tractor is safe and ready for use
- P4 check and adjust operator environment to meet personal requirements
- P5 check the immediate work area for hazards and obstacles before moving off
- P6 use the correct warning signals at all times
- P7 operate and manoeuvre the tractor safely and as instructed
- P8 change driving techniques to take into account any changes in weather, ground conditions and types of terrain
- P9 deal with any hazards and obstacles encountered during operation in accordance with instructions
- P10 stop and isolate tractor on completion of activity in line with instructions
- P11 leave the tractor secure after use and in a suitable condition for future use
- P12 carry out all work in accordance with relevant environmental and health and safety legislation, risk assessment requirements, codes of practice and company policies

# Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 the type of clothing and personal protective equipment suitable for the activity
- K2 current legislation in relation to the use of tractors
- K3 the required pre-start checks and adjustments and the reasons why these must be carried out
- K4 how to mount and dismount safely
- K5 how to start and stop the tractor
- K6 the function of all controls and instuments
- K7 appropriate use of warning signals and indicators
- K8 the ways in which the tractor should be operated and manoeuvred, and how different weather, ground conditions and types of terrain must be taken into account
- K9 the capabilities and limitations of the tractor and operator
- K10 types of hazards and obstacles which may be encountered and how these should be dealt with
- K11 the reasons why the tractor should be left in a suitable condition for future use
- K12 why it is important to maintain safety and security of the tractor at all times
- K13 your responsibilities under relevant environmental and health and safety legislation, codes of practice and company policies
