

Overview This standard is about being able to assist with harnessing up horses for use as instructed. It includes being able to identify parts of the harness, and assist with putting it on the horse as well as taking it off.

The work described in this standard would be carried out under the direction of a supervisor.

You will need to be fully aware of the importance of health and safety in connection with this work.

Performance criteria

You must be able to: P1 Put on a head collar and tie up the horse using a quick release knot

- P2 Assist with maintaining control of the horse whilst working
 - P3 Select the correct harness for the intended horse, according to instructions
- P4 Assist with putting the harness on the horse
- P5 Assist with unharnessing the horse after use
- P6 Tidy the area after work
- P7 Clean and store the harness after use
- P8 Dispose of waste materials correctly
- P9 Work in a way which maintains the safety of self and others.

- K11 How to work in a way which maintains the safety of self and others.
