- P1 Assess the quantity and quality of grazing to ensure it is appropriate for grazing horses
- P2 Confirm that the boundaries are safe and secure, and where appropriate report any problems
- P3 Make an adequate supply of clean water available
- P4 Recognise and minimise hazards or report them to the appropriate person
- P5 Maintain the health and safety of horses, self and others during the work.

- K2 The different methods of providing water for grazing horses
- K3 The importance of clean grazing in preventing parasitic infections

- K6 The location of a gate and appropriate measures for securing gates
- K7 Risks to horses, yourself and others and how these can be minimised, or reported
- K8 Your responsibilities under relevant animal health and welfare and health and safety legislation/codes of practice
