You will need to be fully aware of the importance of animal health and welfare and health and safety in connection with this work.

You will need to be able to recognise hazards and assess risks within the workplace.

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 Check that the area is suitable for long reining exercise and take the appropriate action if it is not
- P2 Check that the horse is in a fit condition to be long reined
- P3 Wear the appropriate personal protective equipment
- P4 Select, check and fit suitable long rein tack and equipment according to instructions
- P5 Maintain control of the horse at all times appropriate to the conditions
- P6 Use appropriate methods to long rein the horse according to instructions
- P7 Remove and store tack and equipment
- P8 Maintain the health and safety of horses, self and others during the work.

You need to know and understand:

- K1 Your role and responsibilities in long reining horses for exercise
- K2 The reasons for long reining
- K3 How to check the horse is fit to be long reined, and recognise signs of illhealth, lameness or injury which would affect the horse's welfare if worked
- K4 Types and use of tack and equipment including cavesson and long reins
- K5 Personal protective equipment which should be worn
- K6 Procedures associated with long reining horses
- K7 Different methods of long reining depending on intended use of the horse
- K8 How to maintain control of the horse at all times
- K9 The ways in which conditions, such as weather, surface and other horses affect the process
- K10 The length of time a horse can be long reined and why this is important
- K11 Your responsibilities under relevant animal health and welfare and health and safety legislation/codes of practice.
