- K1 The health and welfare concerns associated with racing and the actions to be taken
- K2 Hazards likely to be encountered when controlling horses after racing
- K3 Post race procedures which must be followed including escorting winners to enclosures and escorting to veterinary box
- K4 Dope testing procedures
- K5 The importance of providing water correctly after racing
- K6 Health problems which may occur after racing e.g. lameness, minor injuries
- K7 Risks to horses, yourself and others and how these can be minimised
- K8 The role of the farrier, vet and racecourse officials and when you may need their assistance
- K9 Your responsibilities under relevant animal health and welfare and health and safety legislation/codes of practice.
