

#### **Overview**

This standard is about being able to drive a single harness horse in an enclosed area to a basic level of competence, under the supervision of an experienced driver.

It involves being able to handle the reins and whip correctly, make effective use of a Harness Horse Groom, and drive a series of basic movements correctly.

You will need to be fully aware of the importance of animal health and welfare and health and safety in connection with this work.

You will need to be able to recognise hazards and assess risks within the workplace.
