

This standard involves planning diets and implementing feeding regimes for **Overview** horses. You should be able to identify the dietary requirements of horses and decide the quantity of feed required. You will also need to deal with any necessary supplements to the diet and special dietary requirements. It is essential that your work identifies any necessary changes in dietary requirements and allows for changes in the ration.

> You will need to be fully aware of the importance of animal health and welfare and health and safety in connection with this work.

You will need to be able to recognise hazards and assess risks within the workplace.
