

Overview

This standard is about preparing and maintaining the quality, quantity and suitability of grazing land for horses. This includes identifying and controlling the presence of weeds and poisonous plants, identifying and removing hazards, ensuring an adequate supply of suitable water and checking boundaries.

You will need to be fully aware of the importance of health and safety in connection with this work.

You will need to be able to recognise hazards and assess risks.

Performance criteria

You must be able to: P1 Assess that the quantity and quality of grazing is appropriate for grazing horses

- P2 Identify and control the presence of weeds and poisonous plants
- P3 Identify the presence of any hazards and take the appropriate action
- P4 Assess and maintain the safety and security of boundaries
- P5 Provide and maintain an adequate supply of uncontaminated water
- P6 Record the condition of the grazing land
- P7 Monitor and maintain the health and safety of horses, self and others during the work.
