You will need to be able to recognise hazards and assess risks within the workplace.

- P5 Monitor and maintain the health and safety of horses, self and others during the work.

- K3 The necessary fitness prior to the covering season

- K6 How to identify health problems and the appropriate action to take
- K7 Problems that may occur during exercise and feeding and the appropriate action to take
- K8 Risks to horses, yourself and others and how these can be minimised
- K9 Your responsibilities under relevant animal health and welfare and health and safety legislation/codes of practice.
