- P4 Negotiate terms and conditions of contracts, and methods and manner of supply with clients
- P5 Ensure staff are aware of their responsibilities in relation to providing harness horse services legally and in accordance with codes of practice
- P6 Select and prepare suitable horses, harnesses and vehicles for the intended use
- P7 Plan routes with regard to customer requirements, safety and horse welfare
- P8 Carry out risk assessments on routes and venues
- P9 Ensure horses are trained for the intended purpose
- P10 Drive horses for the purposes of providing commercial harness horse services.
