

## Clean and prepare horse drawn vehicles or agricultural implements for use, under supervision

---

### Overview

This standard is about being able to clean and prepare horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements for use, under supervision.

It includes being able to wash, polish and lubricate selected parts of the vehicle, as instructed, and to assist with moving horse-drawn vehicles and implements for cleaning, use and storage. It also includes being able to identify basic parts of the vehicle or implement and to store vehicles and implements.

The work described in this standard would be carried out under the direction of a supervisor. This could be direct supervision or it could be through providing instructions and monitoring work.

You will need to be fully aware of the importance of health, safety and animal welfare in connection with this activity.

## Performance criteria

You must be able to:

1. wear appropriate clothing and personal protective equipment for the activity, according to instructions
2. prepare the work area and assemble required cleaning materials, under supervision
3. use cleaning materials in accordance with instructions
4. clean and prepare horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements, under supervision
5. assist with the moving of horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements for cleaning, use or storage
6. store horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements, as instructed
7. dispose of waste materials safely and correctly
8. be aware of the health and safety of yourself and others, and the welfare of the horse during the activity

## Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

1. the use and care of personal protective equipment
2. your role and responsibilities in cleaning horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements
3. the basic parts of the horse-drawn vehicle or agricultural implement
4. how to clean horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements
5. how to move horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements safely and effectively for cleaning, use or storage
6. the importance of drying and lubricating horse-drawn vehicles or agricultural implements correctly
7. how to use equipment and cleaning materials correctly and safely
8. the correct methods for disposal of waste
9. your responsibilities for health, safety and animal welfare.
