

[Prepare and care for horse drawn vehicles, agricultural implements, and related equipment]



Overview

This standard involves working under supervision to be able to prepare horse drawn vehicles, horse drawn agricultural implements and driving-related equipment for use, and caring for them after use. It will involve cleaning the vehicle/implement and equipment to the required standard ready for use, carrying out pre-drive routine safety checks, reporting findings and taking action as instructed to ensure the vehicle/implement and equipment are fit for the intended purpose.

The standard also involves being able to identify different types of horse drawn vehicles, agricultural implements and driving related equipment, and their parts, and understanding their correct uses and functions

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 Clean the vehicle/implement/equipment to a standard appropriate for the intended use
- P2 Carry out routine maintenance
- P3 Carry out pre-use checks of the vehicle/implement/equipment for wear, tear and damage
- P4 Take action as instructed to ensure the vehicle/implement/equipment is fit for purpose before use
- P5 Ensure all driving related equipment is correctly in place prior to use
- P6 Care for the vehicle/implement/equipment after use, and carry out postuse checks for signs of wear, tear or damage
- P7 Report any areas of concern and take action as instructed
- P8 Store the vehicle/implement/equipment appropriately after use
- P9 Work in a way which maintains the safety of self and others

- K4 The importance of carrying out pre and post use checks for wear, tear or damage
- K5 How to carry out routine maintenance
- K6 How to store correctly between uses
- K7 How to work in a way which maintains the safety of self and others.
