Support and advise anglers on a fishery



Overview

This standard is about providing support to anglers. It covers ensuring that anglers comply with fisheries regulations as well as providing advice and information to anglers regarding the fishery. It includes communication skills and being able to maintain accurate records regarding fishing activity using routine and non-routine tasks.

This standard requires the ability to ensure that anglers comply with the regulations regarding individual fishery requirements and national requirements.

This standard requires the ability to provide information on features of the fishery, environmental factors, fishing methods, safety, legal restrictions controlling angling and methods of fish handling and release.

This standard requires that you carry out work safely in line with legal health and safety requirements and that you work to maintain bio-security and minimise environmental disturbance at all times.

The legislation controlling the application of this standard will vary depending on the location of the fishery within England, Wales, Northern Ireland or Scotland.

- K11 how environmental factors can influence angling
- K12 why it is important to maintain fishery records
- K13 the importance of maintaining a polite and courteous manner at all times
