  - P3 plan the clearance and preparation of the site in accordance with specifications and the condition of the site
  - P4 ensure that the working methods for site clearance and preparation are established and clearly communicated
  - P5 identify and establish the availability of resources required for site clearance and preparation
  - P6 confirm that equipment and materials are fit for purpose
  - P7 establish measures for the recycling or disposal of waste in accordance with legal and organisational requirements
  - P8 establish measures to maintain suitable levels of hygiene and biosecurity
  - P9 ensure that working methods and processes are suitable to the site and that resources are used effectively and efficiently
  - P10 oversee site clearance and preparation in accordance with specifications and maintain the quality of work
  - P11 confirm that the site is in a condition ready for planting operations to begin
  - P12 ensure appropriate records are completed as required by relevant legislation and the organisation
  - P13 ensure that environmental and health and safety policies and risk assessment requirements are put into practice across your area of responsibility
