Co-ordinate the planting of crops or plants



Overview

This standard covers the co-ordination of planting crops or plants in outdoor or protected conditions

This standard is for those whose work role is to co-ordinate the planting of crops or plants outdoors or in protected conditions. It is applicable to planting by hand or by machine.

This standard covers the coordination of your own work load, it may in some instances involve coordinating the work of teams.

This includes planting crops or plants in any horticulture setting, whether amenity (green roofs, gardens, sports turf etc) or production (fruit, vegetable, trees etc).

The identification and establish the availability of resources required for planting will include the need to identify plants by the common and botanical names. As well as knowledge of common and botanical names this standard will also cover grouping of different plants.

You will require considerable knowledge of the principles and methods of planting operations.

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 assess the risks associated with the site and the required activity
- P2 carry out an environmental assessment of the site before starting work
- P3 confirm conditions for planting are optimum
- P4 ensure the necessary working methods for planting are established and clearly communicated
- P5 ensure that planting takes place at the appropriate time to optimise plant growth and development
- P6 identify and establish the availability of resources required for planting
- P7 establish measures for the recycling or disposal of waste in accordance with legal and organisational requirements
- P8 establish measures to maintain suitable levels of hygiene and biosecurity
- P9 ensure the quality of the plant material and work methods meets specifications
- P10 ensure the plant material is prepared according to specifications
- P11 ensure plants are positioned within the growing medium according to specifications
- P12 ensure plant material is handled in a manner which optimises establishment, growth and development, and prevents damage
- P13 ensure the integrity of the site is maintained
- P14 assess the need to apply plant protection
- P15 ensure appropriate records are completed as required by relevant legislation and the organisation
- P16 your responsibilities under current environmental and health and safety legislation, codes of practice and company policies
