# Performance criteria

P1	carry out all work in accordance with relevant environmental, health and safety legislation and animal health and welfare legislation, risk assessment requirements, codes of practice and company policies
P2	select, prepare, use and maintain tools, equipment and materials that are appropriate for the work, safely and affectively
P3	use correct method to de-cap honeycombs and separate the capping from the honey
P4	ensure the honey is strained and settled correctly after extraction so as to prevent contamination
P5	ensure honey is bottled and labelled using the correct method
P6	use correct methods to extract other saleable products from the bee hive
P7	deal with waste safely and correctly in accordance with legislation
P8	maintain suitable levels of hygiene and bio-security
P9	maintain effective communication with colleagues and others involved in or affected by the work
P10	maintain records as appropriate
