- K4 the techniques for administering medication (by various routes) that owners will have to be familiar with
- K5 how to communicate effectively with clients
- K6 appropriate infection control measures
- K7 your professional responsibilities as a registered veterinary nurse
- K8 your responsibilities for the health and welfare of animals under current legislation and codes of practice
