You must be able to:	P1	obtain the necessary information on patients for the medical procedure or investigation e.g. size, age, weight, history, concurrent medical treatment and passport section XI for equines
	P2	identify the medical procedure or investigation to be performed and the patient preparation required
	P3	transport and handle the patient safely and correctly using the appropriate equipment and methods whilst ensuring the patient is kept as calm and comfortable as possible
	P4	restrain the patient sufficiently to allow the preparation to be carried out safely and without risk of injury to the patient or people
	P5	ensure there is adequate access to the patient to allow the medical procedure or investigation to be performed
	P6	assess the potential risks to health and safety in this area of work
	P7	comply with animal health and welfare legislation and codes of practice
	P8	assess the five freedoms of the animal and how they may be addressed or affected whilst in your care
	P9	select and implement appropriate infection control procedures
	P10	maintain your own professional conduct
