Overview	This standard is about carrying out post-planting tree protection and maintenance in line with specification					
	Depending on the tree type and size and on the nature of the planting scheme, post-planting protection and maintenance may take many forms					
	Maintenance covers maintenance of support systems and plants					
	Protection is the protection of the tree from a range of damaging agents such as insects, mammals and the weather. It is not about managing or controlling of pest populations					
	This standard is for those involved in tree protection and maintenance following planting					

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# Performance criteria

- P2 check that the condition of materials is satisfactory and/or match the requirements of the specification and report any defects or deficiencies in materials to the relevant person
- P3 carry out **protection** in line with the specification avoiding damage to the planted trees and to the environment
- P4 carry out **maintenance** in line with the specification avoiding damage to the planted trees and to the environment
- P5 follow organisational and industry environmental good practice and minimise environmental damage
- P6 maintain the health and safety of yourself and others at all times in accordance with current legislation
