Process arisings from treework operations



Overview

This standard is about processing arisings from treework operations.

Processing and disposal could include stacking, burning, burying, reducing, re-using or spreading.

Your work must conform to all relevant legislation and codes of practice when carrying out this work.





Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- 1. assess the risks associated with the site and the proposed work
- 2. select and implement the appropriate working methods, in accordance with the assessed risks
- select and use the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) for the work
- 4. select, prepare and use the appropriate tools and equipment, safely and effectively
- 5. confirm all equipment has been checked and is fit for purpose
- 6. prepare the arisings from treework operations in accordance with the specification, the site, relevant legislation and industry guidelines
- 7. process the arisings from treework operations appropriate to their condition, the specification and the site requirements
- 8. communicate with others and maintain affective team work
- 9. deal with any problems within your level of responsibility
- 10. follow the environmental good practice set by your organisation and the industry, and minimise environmental damage
- 11. ensure the site is left in a condition which meets environmental requirements, in accordance with the specification
- 12. maintain the health and safety of yourself and others, in accordance with relevant legislation





Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- 1. how to identify hazards and assess risks
- 2. how to interpret risk assessments
- 3. the selection, use and care of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- 4. the types of tools and equipment required and how to maintain and use these safely and effectively in line with the manufacturer's recommendations
- 5. the legal requirements for checking equipment
- 6. different uses for the arisings including; burning, stacking, burying, spreading, further processing, re-use as another product
- 7. how to select the appropriate method of processing the arisings from treework operations
- 8. how to select the appropriate method of disposal or onward transport of the arisings from treework operations
- 9. how to comply with relevant legislation regarding disposal, transport and storage of the arisings from treework operations
- the potential impact of your work on the environment and how this can be minimized
- 11. the importance of checking how well you worked with others to process arisings
- 12. the importance of checking how well you dealt with any problems when processing arisings
- 13. your responsibilities under relevant environmental, health and safety legislation and codes of practice
