Overview

This standard is about the management of operations related to establishing and maintaining tree(s). It includes the operations required to carry out the establishment and subsequent work as set out in a scheme and meeting approved standards. The standard covers establishing new woodland and maintaining existing woodland using silvicultural systems as well as individual trees to achieve a wide range of management objectives

This unit requires a general knowledge of operations and site planning in terms of:

- soil types
- water drainage requirements on a range of sites
- tree species requirements, ecological benefits and end uses
- interpretation of survey and geographical information
- managing labour
- costs
- legislation
- silviculture

This standard is for those who are responsible for managing establishment and maintenance operations

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 assess the risks associated with the site and the proposed work
- P2 select and implement appropriate working methods in accordance with the assessed risks
- P3 determine the specification for establishment and maintenance according to the site management objectives
- P4 determine and implement the monitoring requirements of the establishment operations
- P5 specify materials required for the work to meet the work specification
- P6 oversee the ordering and handling of specified planting stock to meet the site and management objectives
- P7 select and appoint contractors to conduct harvesting and extraction operations
- P8 decide on **protection methods** for the planted stock in relation to damaging agents and other site related elements such as fencing, tree shelters etc
- P9 confirm the planting complies with stated objectives, undertaking maintenance operations where necessary
- P10 monitor the establishment project against the objectives in terms of timeframes, quality, cost, results achieved, plan objectives and standard achieved
- P11 manage any deviations from the specification
- P12 maintain the health and safety of yourself and others at all times in accordance with current legislation
- P13 follow organisational and industry environmental good practice and minimise environmental damage
