- P4 ensure that people in the priority groups are called and recalled for assessment at the established intervals
- P5 take account of financial and human resources in developing the plan

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 the information technology available to maintain registers and call and recall people for assessments, and how to select and use it
- K2 the importance of monitoring whether responsibilities are being carried out and how to do so in a positive manner
- K3 the importance of taking account of financial and human resources when developing plans
- K4 coding systems, and how they can be used to identify people in high risk groups
- K5 the factors which determine the risk of CHD and the relative impact of these factors
- K6 how factors in people's lifestyles (ie physical activity, smoking, diet, stress, alcohol consumption) can affect their risk of developing CHD
- K7 the nature of CHD, its different forms and its physical, psychological and social effects on individuals and their families
- K8 national and local guidelines and policies for identifying and assessing people at significant risk of developing CHD
- K9 evidence to help establish which criteria to use to identify people at significant risk of developing CHD
- K10 the range of tools and methodologies for assessing individuals' risk of CHD
- K11 how to select appropriate tools and methodologies for assessing individuals' risk of CHD based on evidence
- K12 the resources available, competing demands on resources and how to balance these in an efficient, effective and equitable way
