# Schedule theatre and staff time for living organ donation



#### **Overview**

This standard is about identifying, organising and mobilising the surgical, anaesthetic and ancillary resources necessary for an efficient transplantation operation.

Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.

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## Performance criteria

#### You must be able to:

- P1 make an accurate estimate of how long the theatres are required and which staff need to be involved
- P2 ensure that the theatres are within easy access of each other
- P3 ensure timely transfers of donor and recipient if the same theatre is being used
- P4 communicate your requirements as soon as possible to the theatre manager and staff manager
- P5 communicate your requirements as soon as possible to the anaesthetic department
- P6 communicate if necessary with ICU staff that the operation is taking place and confirm availability of bed space

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## Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K3 organisational communication pathways
- K4 how to adapt communication styles in ways which are appropriate to different people
