
Overview

This standard is about managing information governance within the health sector. You will need to be able to identify and evaluate the appropriate use of information and enable appropriate information sharing. You will also need to be able to prepare, conduct and report information governance audits.

Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.

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Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 identify and evaluate the appropriate use of data and information
- P2 carry out appropriate public consultation exercises concerning the use and sharing of data and information
- P3 enable appropriate data and information sharing
- P4 ensure the appropriate response to any identified risks takes place
- P5 prepare and conduct an IG audit in accordance with National Guidelines
- P6 accurately report the results of an IG audit to internal and external audiences
- P7 provide robust advice and guidance to colleagues on IG related topics
- P8 contribute to improving knowledge and understanding of IG across your organisation
- P9 contribute to improving IG related policies and procedures

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Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 the relevant legislation, policies, procedures, codes of practice and guidelines in relation to information governance
- K2 the professional codes of ethics in your area of practice and other relevant areas subject to the IG audit
- K3 the components of information governance, including; information quality, confidentiality, data protection, information security and records management
- K4 the healthcare systems where information may be governed
- K5 the relationship of information governance to other governance areas including clinical, corporate and financial, and the rights and responsibilities where there is overlap
- K6 how to identify and evaluate the appropriate use of data and information
- K7 standards for data and information sharing
- K8 how to conduct and report an Information Governance audit
- K9 the ways in which you can contribute to improving Information Governance
