## Verify and package contact lenses



#### **Overview**

This standard is about verifying the final specification of the contact lenses, and packaging and labelling them to meet organisational requirements. It should be noted that, for some types of lens (e.g. soft lenses), performance criteria will include hydration and sterilisation of the lens. Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.
