## Assure the quality of eye prostheses



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### Overview

This standard is about assuring the quality of custom made eye prostheses. Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.

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### Performance criteria

*You must be able to:*

- P1 confirm the work instructions
- P2 confirm that the equipment to be used is in safe working order, and has been correctly set up
- P3 assure the quality of your work against the specification
- P4 identify and resolve any problems in complying with the specification
- P5 dispose of surplus material correctly
- P6 record relevant information correctly and legibly, and store records correctly
- P7 carry out your work safely
- P8 maintain the required standards of cleanliness

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### Knowledge and understanding

*You need to know and understand:*

- K1 the manufacturing specifications
- K2 where to find, and how to use, the Standard Operating Procedure for the work instruction
- K3 how to interpret the work instruction
- K4 when equipment is in safe working order
- K5 how to operate equipment safely
- K6 how to identify faulty and defective materials, and how to dispose of them
- K7 how to recognise defects associated with custom made eye prosthesis processing
- K8 the documentation to be completed, and the recording and storing systems
- K9 your responsibilities under the Health and Safety at Work Act, and the implications of non-compliance
- K10 the required standards of cleanliness, and how to maintain them
