# Interpret research findings and implement them in practice



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### Overview

This standard covers interpreting research findings and implementing them in practice.

Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.

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#### Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 identify, select and summarise in a suitable format relevant and current qualitative and quantitative information about knowledge and practice and disseminate it appropriately
  - P2 provide information to individuals and groups in relevant contexts and present it at pace, and in a style and form, which is appropriate to their needs
  - P3 provide opportunities for recipients to ask questions, seek clarification and give feedback
  - P4 reach agreements with stakeholders about implementing research in practice which strike the best balance between
    - P4.1 improving health and wellbeing
    - P4.2 the issues and concerns of those with an interest in implementation
    - P4.3 available resources
    - P4.4 national priorities and strategies
  - P5 propose and agree courses of action
    - P5.1 focused on the purpose and intended outcomes of implementation
    - P5.2 that limit any obstacles
    - P5.3 detail who is to do what and by when
  - P6 communicate action plans in a style and form appropriate to those who are to implement them following agreement from those concerned
  - P7 provide the appropriate level and type of support for implementation
  - P8 monitor and review implementation against anticipated outcomes and make any necessary adjustments with the agreement of stakeholders

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#### Knowledge and understanding

- K2 identifying steps for the implementation of recommendations based on research where this is appropriate and possible, including the involvement of stakeholders in the research process

- K4 planning the application of research findings to improve a specific area of practice
- K5 evaluating and reviewing research-based implementation for the improvements made to practice
- K6 applying influencing and negotiation skills to work with stakeholders on implementing research findings in practice
- K7 effective project management and support skills in the implementation of research findings
