Classify items and make up loads



Overview

This standard is aimed at staff involved in laundering items such as bed linen, clothing and towels. To achieve this unit, you must show that you can prepare items and make up loads for cleaning. You must handle items with care and remove items which are unsuitable for the cleaning process. You must check for objects that are extraneous and deal with them according to correct procedures. You must sort items according to the appropriate classifications and make up loads of the correct weight, labelling them clearly. You must prioritise loads and store them carefully in order of priority.

Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.
