- 5. use feedback to enhance your performance
- 6. maintain the currency of your technical knowledge in relation to your job role and function

You need to know and understand:

- 1. the requirements of organisational procedures
- 2. your personal professional objectives and your organisation's priorities and expectations
- 3. the importance of feedback on your performance
- 4. the requirements of your role and level of responsibility
- 5. development opportunities available and how to access these
