- P4 ensure that your records of the intelligence analysis product are clear and accurate
- P5 comply with all relevant legislation, codes of practice, standards, protocols, procedures and guidelines

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 the relevant terms of reference
- K2 how to review the objectives within the terms of reference with regard to results of the analysis
- K3 the purpose of the intelligence analysis product and how to produce it
- K4 the importance of the accuracy, currency, relevance, timeliness and sufficiency of the intelligence analysis product
- K5 how to use reasoned argument to influence and support decision making based on your analysis
- K6 the procedures and necessary content of records of the analysis, including the assumptions and decisions made at each stage
- K7 the relevant national, local, professional and organisational requirements relating to information usage, its handling and analysis
- K8 the reasons why it is important to comply, and the potential consequences of non-compliance, with relevant legislation, codes of practice, standards, protocols, procedures and guidelines
