Establish appropriate intervention in large scale complex corporate cases



Overview

This unit concerns identifying the appropriate intervention once the nature of non-compliance has been established. You need to evaluate the amount and risks at stake and decide whether to pursue the case and you will need to evaluate a wide range of the potential implications. The complexity of cases will be defined by the case itself, the size or complexity of the business structure, the volume of business, the market and the location of the business base.

Scope/range related to performance criteria

- wider implications: probability of winning the case; likelihood of subsequent compensation claims; good and bad publicity for the organisation; need for new legislation; cost to the customer; resourceeffectiveness
- complexity: of the case; large size and/or high complexity of business structure; volume of business; market (UK/overseas); location of business base
