Contribute to the development of legislation needed for policy implementation



Overview

Policy development often leads to an involvement in preparation and drafting of legislation that is needed for successful policy implementation. This unit is about the contribution that a policy developer makes to the process of turning policy into supporting legislation.

- P8 review draft legislation to match it with policy intentions and recommend amendments to legal specialists
- P9 support legal specialists in the presentation of draft legislation to policy stakeholders
- P10 work with legal specialists to finalise legal drafting that will permit full policy implementation

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Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 specific legislation, regulation and cultural requirements that relate to the nation or region to which the policy will apply
- K2 that the policy formation process involves continuous engagement and partnership with a range of stakeholders meaning that those in policy functions must coordinate and on occasions take the lead but must also constantly seek to ensure that there is full stakeholder engagement
- K3 what information and level of detail is needed by legal specialists to draft legislation that reflects policy intentions
- K4 how to identify features of policy which require legal backing
- K5 why it is important to identify links with existing legislation which may need amendment to complement policy intentions
- K6 how to identify policy features that will become cornerstones of legislation to allow implementation
- K7 the key linguistic requirements of legal drafting
- K8 how to match policy intentions with legal drafting requirements
