SFKWCDE8 Establish requirements for special measures at court



Overview

This unit is about determining whether the circumstances of the case require special arrangements to be made for the witness in court. Where such circumstances are identified, it includes making the appropriate arrangements.

There are two elements:

- 1. Determine circumstances requiring the arrangements of special measures
- 2. Present a case for special measures to be provided

This unit is for Witness Care Officers and others whose responsibilities include undertaking needs assessments of civilians, victims and witnesses in preparation for their appearing in court.
