

## **Overview**

This standard is about planning the storage of supplies in the supply chain. It includes identifying requirements, reviewing how supplies are stored and resolving problems. It also involves reviewing benefits, selecting and planning methods for improving storage, and gaining commitment from stakeholders and colleagues.

This standard is for supply chain practitioners. This could, for example, be in purchasing, freight logistics operations or transport management roles.

- 6. plan the storage of supplies in the supply chain
- 7. obtain the commitment of **stakeholders** and **colleagues** to implement the plan
