This Standard is about ensuring that versions of the finished master are duplicated and made available and supplied on tape, film, disc or file in the formats required.

Deliver a master to format

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 verify the expectations of the client and the requirements of end users
- P2 ensure that finished masters are duplicated, logged and available in all formats that the client requires and end users will need
- P3 where masters are not available in the required formats liaise with colleagues who can resolve the problem
- P4 ensure that copying into additional formats retains the required quality of the product
- P5 supply copies on tape, film, disc or file to each person or organisation as they require
- P6 ensure masters are safely stored and logged
- P7 check that the material you supply is complete and functioning
- P8 verify that requirements of compliance have been met
- P9 include necessary and expected documentation
- P10 check with those to whom you provide copies that their requirements are met

You need to know and understand:

- K1 requirements of clients and those people and organisations that will receive masters
- K2 formats used in masters
- K3 requirements of file formats and file conversions and handling
- K4 impact of file formats and conversions on technical quality and deliverable standards
- K5 current viewing standards and current professional, national and international deliverable standards and expressions of best practice for a range of platforms
- K6 procedures for converting formats
- K7 operation of copying equipment
- K8 documentation that should accompany delivered masters
- K9 storage and logging conventions
- K10 requirements of compliance and organisational procedures that must be met before delivering a master to a client
