## Brood and grow young birds



#### **Overview**

This standard covers the brooding and growing of young birds.

The brooding and growing of birds will involve the monitoring and maintenace of appropriate environmental conditions, the correct handling of the birds and the methods involved in the monitoring of bird growth.

When working with livestock or machinery you need to be appropriately trained in line with current legislation, and hold a relevant award where appropriate.

This standard is suitable for those involved in brooding and growing young birds.

	P2	check brooding/growing areas and environmental conditions are suitable for the reception of young birds

	P5	maintain and adjust environmental conditions to optimise growth, health and welfare
	P6	monitor and replenish food and water supplies when required
	P7	monitor young birds behaviour and take the correct actions to promote their health and well being
	P8	remove and deal with sick or damaged birds in the correct way
	P9	check, as instructed, that the growth of young birds meets production targets and report any issues to the appropriate person
	P10	maintain records as appropriate
	P11	carry out all work in accordance with relevant environmental, health and safety legislation and animal health and welfare legislation, risk assessment requirements, codes of practice and company policies
	P12	deal with waste safely and correctly in accordance with instructions
	P13	maintain suitable levels of hygiene and bio-security
