	P7	ensure food and water supplies are monitored and replenished as required by the system and production requirements
	P8	ensure appropriate records are maintained and stored as required by relevant legislation and the organisation
	P9	ensure that environmental and health and safety policies and risk assessment requirements are put into practice across your area of responsibility
	P10	establish measures for the recycling or disposal of waste in accordance with legal and organisational requirements
	P11	establish measures to maintain suitable levels of hygiene and bio- security
