Prepare indoor accommodation for livestock



Overview

This standard covers the preparation of indoor accommodation for livestock. This involves preparing the accommodation and setting up all equipment ready for use by livestock which should conform to codes of practice for the livestock concerned.

When working with livestock or machinery you need to be appropriately trained in line with current legislation, and hold a relevant award where appropriate.

You must carry out your work in a way which will consider any impact on the natural environment.

This standard is suitable for those involved in the preparation of indoor accommodation for livestock.

| P7 | carry out all work in accordance with relevant environmental, health and safety legislation and animal health and welfare legislation, risk assessment requirements, codes of practice and company policies |
| P8 | deal with waste safely and correctly in accordance with legislation |
